Woodland Observation Bingo

Mark a square when you spot it from the recognised path. Tick, colour or point. A full line is bingo; a full card is a Glitchlet sweep.

 Moss on a stone	 A fork in the path	 A pine cone	 A bird in a tree
 A fallen log	 An unusual rock	 A wooden marker	 Ferns by the path
 A puddle - look only	 A hollow tree	 Blue-ish berries - do not pick	 A hanging branch
 Lichen on bark	 A clearing seen from the path	 A squirrel or drey	 A tiny-looking door

Stay on the path. Look - do not pick, poke, climb or chase. At home, mark anything you honestly remember from a wood, park or picture.
